OBJECTIVE: To provide a terminal disinfection service at a fair and reasonable price to the local government and prepare reimbursement education and supporting documents for the Clarksburg Water board.

FACTS: Back in March 2020, the president signed into law the cares Relief act. WV received 1.25 Billion dollars from the 150 Billion allocated by congress. Governor Justice has made available 200 million of this fund for local government to reimburse their department for expenditures associated with fighting the virus. There were 56 line items under the Cares act that were eligible, but numerous entities failed to take advantage of due to various reasons not mentioned.

PROBLEM: Local Government employees and residents were at high risk of Covid 19 Virus infection due to the residents' routine practice of paying their bills in person by cash or check; this created a high traffic area. Many customers in Clarksburg were not familiar with online bill pay; therefore, the waterboard dealt with 40 to 50 customers a day.

SOLUTION: Bacteria Busters Pro developed a plan that consisted of servicing the waterboard weekly via ULV fogging, providing education on "How to submit invoices to the government for reimbursement," and providing the supporting documents required for reimbursement

EVALUATION: To our knowledge to date- the Clarksburg Water Board has avoided an outbreak and has successfully received reimbursement under the cares act for weekly sprayings.

CONCLUSION:
